



## **CTA 2023 AGM Website Report – Angus King**

Management and operations of the website was mostly uneventful during 2022. Due to the efforts of the various coordinators and fellow committee members the site has continued to provide a useful web presence for the club including a calendar of all upcoming events.

Website traffic is similar to 2022 with individual stats other than bandwidth being 92 to 100%. Bandwidth has increased by over 300% (not sure why).

In late November I changed the website to be a secured site, that is, https rather than http. This means that the connection between you and the website is a secure encrypted connection. It should cause any problems except for some old links.
