Mon 4 Apr 2022	6	Retiree's Run 2022 An unsupported tour over 6 riding days, exploring some tiny towns within the periphery of the northeast wheat belt region. Five overnight stops will be in the towns of Wongan Hills, Ballidu, Kalannie, Dalwallinu and Miling. A 330km loop route on predominantly sealed, quiet back country roads has been devised. The tour will start and finish in the town of Yerecoin, some 145km from Perth via the Tonkin Highway and Great Northern Highway.	330	Trevor
Wed 4 May 2022	18	Queensland Rail Trails Tour This 18 day, self-supported, 980 km tour of Queensland's south-east corner includes the famous Brisbane Valley Rail Trail between Ipswich and Yarraman and the recently built Kingaroy to Goomeri Rail Trail. The tour includes views of the Scenic Rim west of Brisbane, visits historic sites such as the Kingaroy home of famous Queensland Premier Joe Bjelke-Peterson, the beach strip in Noosa, the hilltop towns of Montville and Maleny, and visits the Bee Gees memorial in Redcliff before returning through the mangrove swamps to Brisbane.	980	Stuart
Sat 4 Jun 2022	3	Toodyay 2022 - WA Day Long Weekend The tour will depart and return to the Midland Station, with accommodation at the Freemason's Hotel in Toodyay. The ride from Midland Station to Toodyay on Saturday will head north to Bullsbrook then travel through the Chittering Valley and the Julimar Forest (and yes, up Julimar Road). Sunday will be a day for participants to explore Toodyay and surrounds (or to simply have a rest). An optional short ride is available. The final day, on the Public Holiday Monday, riders will return to Midland Station via Wooroloo, Chidlow and Parkerville, where the ride will take the Heritage Trail to Midland.	184	Christine
