



CTAWA 2021 Grain Silo Art Tour - 17 April to 8 May 2021 REVISION OF EVENT CONDITIONS

Since the 2021 CTAWA Grain Silo Tour was launched a couple of weeks ago, there has been a lot of interest expressed in the event.

This tour is fundamentally predicated on participants being completely self-sufficient by riding the entire route whilst carrying all their gear/equipment/clothes in pannier bags attached to their bicycles.

With travel options outside of WA still limited, it is probably ideal to ensure our membership has every opportunity to participate in this cycling event in a more relaxed manner. In this regard, a dual cab utility with a rear covered area will be introduced as a support vehicle for the tour.

With limited capacity to carry bags, it will be subject to some controls:

- Principally, those participants electing to camp will be provided some relief by being allowed one bag per person to be carried by the vehicle. This bag may contain their camping gear such as: tent, ground sheet, inflatable mat, sleeping bag, small pillow, eating utensils, fuel stove, camp stool etc.
- Those couples choosing to access independently sourced accommodation for the entire route will only be permitted to place one bag between them onto the vehicle.
- Bag size and weight will be closely managed to prevent excesses, even if it means capping the overall number of tour participants.

No other private support vehicles will be allowed to accompany the tour.

Whilst endeavouring to maintain the original spirit of the adventure as best as possible, participants should be mindful riding the event on a completely unencumbered bicycle may create the wrong impression amongst their fellow tourers.

With the possibility of the overall number of tour participants being restricted, early submission of a completed Registration Form would be a sensible idea.
